MRS. ROBERT H. HICKS

The death of Mrs. Ina B. Hicks occurred in her home in Syracuse on January 29, following a long period of incapacity, due to a stroke. She was born in Salisbury on March 1, 1867, and was married to Robert H. Hicks in this village in 1888. They were active in the Universalist churches in Salisbury Center and later in Bridgewater, West Winfield and Syracuse. They made their home in Syracuse beginning in 1920, and were always active workers in the Betts Memorial Universalist Church. Mrs. Hicks served as president of the Ladies' Aid and for many years had charge of the sewing of the Welfare Committee. She was president of the Cayuga Association of Universalist churches for two years. She is survived by her husband; a son, Seward, and a grandson, Charles. Dr. Ellsworth C. Reamon, pastor, conducted the memorial service in her late hom on February 1.
