MRS. J. P. HIER, IDEAL MOTHER, IS DEAD AT 82
Wife of Well Known Business Man Devoted Her Whole Life to Her Family

Mrs. John P. Hier, 82, died this morning at her home in Hierdale in West Willow street. She had been an invalid for three years, but the immediate cause of death was bronchitis.

She was the daughter of the Rev. Jacob Whitney, a Universalist minister of Steuben county, having been born on Nov. 27, 1827. She was married to Mr. Hier in Rochester 60 years ago, and since that time made Syracuse her home. Mr. Hier is one of the leading business men of the city and his real estate holdings are very large.

Mrs. Hier devoted her life to her home and was the mother of seven children. She lived for her children and apparently had no time for social affairs. The surviving children are Mrs. Perry Coon, Mrs. Charles Bettinger and Fred P. Hier.

There will be Universalist services at the funeral on Friday at 2 p.m. The pallbearers will be the four grandsons: Horace W. Hier, John Philip Hier, Fred. P. Hier and Robert Hier.
