Former Little Falls Bandsman Dies

LITTLE FALLS—Franklyn P. Hill, 70, a charter member and former manager of the Little Falls Military Band, died Tuesday in Little Falls Hospital after a brief illness.

He was born on Oct. 28, 1886, in this city, a son of MacClellan [McClellan] and Ella Petrie Hill. In 1904, he married Mary Kiley at St. Mary's Parish House.

A member of the band for more than 50 years, Mr. Hill was employed over 30 years at Wally's Cigar Store.

Surviving are his wife; one son, Leland Hill Sr. of Roanoke, Va.; two daughters, Evelyn and Vivian Hill, both at home; a sister, Mrs. Carmie [Evelyn] Innes of Marcotte, Fla.; three grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
