Mrs. Maryette Hill

Maryette Hill, widow of the late Seth A. Hill, died at her home on South Main street, this village, on Saturday afternoon, June 13, 1908, after a painful illness extending over a period of a year and a half.

Mrs. Hill's maiden name was Maryette Henry. She was born in the south part of this town, December 24th, 1847, and her entire life was spent here. She was united in marriage with Seth A. Hill, February 22, 1867, who died July 4, 1890.

Mrs. Hill leaves three sons: Smith H., of Cohocton; Morris D., of Atlanta, and Charles L., of Syracuse. She also leaves two sisters, Mrs. William Rector of Brown Hill, and Mrs. O. S. Windnagle of Prattsburg.

Deceased was a woman of courage, industry and energy, a loving mother and an untiring worker for her home and family, a staunch friend and wise counselor.

The funeral was held Monday afternoon at the house, Rev. H. P. [Herbert Philbrick] Morrell of Buffalo, a former pastor of the Universalist church of this place, officiating. Interment in Maple View cemetery beside her husband.
