WALTER HILL DIES; FAMILY ACTIVE IN CHURCH

Walter Richard Hill, of 744 Rugby Road, a member of a family long identified with All Souls Universalist Church, died yesterday at his home after a brief illness. He was 57.

Mr. Hill [was] formerly active in the cotton goods business, but had to retire because of failing health. He was born in Brooklyn, a son of the late Richard and Ada Hill, and was a resident of Flatbush for the last 20 years. His parents also were active members of All Souls Church. Mr. Hill had been a member of the church for 34 years and a member of the board of deacons since March 19, 1929.

Surviving are his widow, Caroline C. Hill; two sons, Walter N. and Robert K. Hill, and a brother, Albert K. Hill. The funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday in the Fairchild Chapel, 86 Lefferts Place, with the Rev. Cornelius Greenway, pastor of All Souls Church, officiating. Interment will be in Woodlawn Cemetery.
