DEATHS.

At Union Settlement, Constantia, Oswego county, of consumption, on the 23d of February last, Mrs. MARY HILLS, wife of Benjamin Hills, in the 45th year of her age. Mrs. H. was a firm and consistent believer in the final "restitution of all things," and died in the triumphs of that faith which was an anchor to her soul. She has left a companion and eight children to mourn her departure, but they "sorrow not" as "others which have no hope." On account of the inclemency of the weather, and the almost impassable state of the roads at the time of her death, the funeral services were not performed until the 7th of April, when the writer of this tendered the consolations of the "Gospel of our salvation" to the mourning relatives, friends and neighbors of the deceased.
