Will C. Hinds

The death of Will C. Hinds, a highly respected resident of Cooperstown, occurred after an extended illness on Wednesday afternoon of last week at his home on Chestnut street.

Mr. Hinds was born on a farm in the Fly Creek Valley, June 16, 1859, a son of Charles and Jeanette (Pierson) Hinds. He operated the farm there until thirty-five years ago, when he retired and came to this village. On November 5, 1925, he married Miss Ventie Johnson of Burlington Flats.

Surviving are his widow and an aunt, Mrs. U. J. VanHorne of the Fly Creek Valley and three nephews, Delbert B. Pierson of Syracuse, Charles A. Pierson of Richfield Springs and Robert Pierson of Edmeston.

The funeral was held at the home Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock, the Rev. Charles Kramer, pastor of the Church of the Messiah, Universalist, officiating. Burial was made in the cemetery at Burlington Flats.
