Mrs. Michael Hine passed away at her home in Johnstown at 5:30 Tuesday afternoon of last week, after a long period of invalidism due to a complication of diseases.

Mrs. Myrtle Hine, daughter of Alanson and Adelaide (Scudder) Harris, was born June 12, 1868, in Morris, in which township she had spent the greater part of her life. She was twice married. Her first husband, Lyman Shaul, for many years an engineer on the D. & H. railroad, was killed in an accident at Richmondville in 1910. In 1923, she married Michael Hine of Gloversville, who survives. She had been a consistent member of the Morris Universalist church for many years. A woman of high ideals and unusual kindness of heart, she had surrounded herself with a host of friends, who will deeply mourn her passing.

Immediate surviving relatives are the husband; one brother, Lynn J. Harris of Morris, and numerous nieces and nephews, to all of whom sincere sympathy will be extended.

Funeral services were held at her residence in Johnstown Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Committal services were conducted by her former pastor, the Rev. F. G. Leonard, of the Morris Universalist church, at the Harris family plot in the new part of Hillington cemetery, Friday morning at 10 o'clock.
