George B. Hinkley, 71, member of a family long connected with judicial, newspaper and financial interests of Buffalo, died early this morning in his home, 231 South Buffalo street, Orchard Park, after an illness of a little more than a week.

Mr. Hinkley was a brother of Supreme Court Justice Alonzo G. Hinkley. Other survivors include his widow, a sister, Mrs. Mary Ferguson of Buffalo and two brothers, Elmer H. Hinkley of Buffalo and Frank W. Hinkley of Los Angeles, formerly prominent in Buffalo hotel and newspaper circles.

Born in Buffalo [on] November 3, 1867, Mr. Hinkley was a son of the late Alonzo S. and Theresa Marion Hinkley. He was educated in Buffalo grammar schools and at Old Central high school. He married Miss Mary L. Rinehart in Wheeling, W. Va. [on] February 1, 1902.

Mr. Hinkley for many years was connected with A. J. Wright & Co., which was merged with Abbott, Proctor Paine several years ago. He retired about a year ago. He was a member of the Universalist church and a Mason, belonging to Washington lodge 240 of Buffalo.
