MRS. FRANCIS [sic] CARR HINMAN

J. Francis [sic] Carr, wife of Ira Hinman, passed away at her home on Church street, this village, Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, of heart trouble, following a serious operation a few weeks ago. She was a daughter of Green and Sally (Priest) Carr and was born in the town of Laurens, Aug. 29th, 1850, one of 12 children, of whom there are but three now left. She was married to Ira Hinman in 1872. Mrs. Hinman is survived by her husband, one sister, Mrs. Edward Matterson of New Berlin, two brothers, Edwin Carr of New Lisbon and Richard Carr of Barnes City, Iowa, also nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Hinman was a woman highly respected in the community in which she has lived for about 30 years, and has many friends who will miss her. She was a member of the Universalist church of Morris.

The funeral was held Friday at 2 p. m., from the house, her pastor, the Rev. F. G. Leonard, officiating, and the body placed in the vault in Hillington cemetery.
