Death of Former Hudson Woman

Sarah J. Acly, wife of Charles P. Hoag, of Albany, died in that city on Saturday. The remains will be brought to Hudson for burial, and the funeral will be held from the mortuary chapel in Cedar Park cemetery on Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Mrs. Hoag was born in this city and for fifty years was a member of the First Universalist church of Hudson. She removed to Albany some years ago and was at the time of her death president of the Ladies Circle No. 23, G.A.R., of Albany. She was married thirty-seven years ago to Mr. Hoag, who survives her, also two sons, John A. of Albany, and William H., of Marble Falls, Tex. She also leaves a brother Charles W. Acly, and a sister, Mrs. William Harvey Thomas, both of this city. She has been in failing health for about one year.
