Mrs. Myrtle Hokerk

Funeral services for Mrs. Myrtle Hokerk, 73, of 63 Oxford Road, New Hartford, were held yesterday morning at 11 at the Gordon funeral home in Utica Park. Mrs. Hokerk died Friday in the Utica Memorial hospital.

She was born at Maine, N. Y., July 7, 1867, daughter of the late Morgan L and Josephine L Johnson Heath. She was married to the Rev. Frank O. Hokerk, former Gloversville Universalist church pastor, in 1888. He died in 1931.

Mrs. Hokerk was educated in the schools of Maine, N. Y. and Wyoming Seminary, Pennsylvania, specializing in music. For many years she was prominent in musical circles in Syracuse and Barre, Vt.

She spent the greater part of her life in Syracuse, Barre, Richfield Springs and Gloversville, residing for 10 years in Utica. For the last two years she had lived in New Hartford.

She was a member and former matron of the Eastern Star chapter in Richfield Springs.

Surviving are a son, Lynde D. Hokerk, and a granddaughter, Mrs. Clark Moore, Utica.
