Death of Mrs. Charles Holcomb

Mrs. Fannie Harrington, wife of Charles Holcomb, died at Conneaut Lake, Pa., [on] June 27, 1914, aged about 72 years, after an illness of several months. She was a former resident of Volusia, but resided in Erie for many years. Recently she has made her home in summer at Conneaut Lake, and with her daughters in the winter. Besides her husband she leaves one son and three daughters.

The funeral was held at the home of George Holcomb, near Haight's Corners, Monday afternoon, Rev. W. G. Price [Universalist] attending. The burial was in the Holcomb Cemetery nearby.¹
