JOHN A. HOLCOMB DIES AT HIS HOME IN CANTON

Canton, Aug. 4.—John A. Holcomb, 67, died early Sunday morning at his residence in Hodskin street of liver trouble following an illness of about three weeks.

Mr. Holcomb was born Jan. 22, 1857, in Potsdam, a son of Edmund and Hannah Knight Holcomb and resided with them until a young man when he purchased a farm in Pierrepont where he lived for 20 years. He moved to this village 18 years ago and became a dealer in farm machinery and automobiles in which business he continued until his last illness.
