[Holmes, Lemuel]

Capt. Lemuel Holmes, for many years identified with the business and official interests of our city, died at his home in Claverack, last evening. He was born in Maine in 1813. During his long life he was closely connected with the First Universalist Church of this city, and devoted his personal supervision to the construction of the new church building on Warren street. He served the city faithfully as alderman, water commissioner, and as commissioner of the Hudson cemetery, and the county as Commissioner of Loans and as Supervisor. He commanded several boats on the Hudson river and earned the reputation of being a careful and efficient officer.
