DEATH REMOVES ALLIE HOMKEY OF FORT PLAIN

FORT PLAIN, April 24—Mrs. Allie Casler Homkey, 69, widow of Charles Homkey, died Saturday night in St. Mary's Hospital, Amsterdam. She had been ill only a short time.

Mrs. Homkey was born in the Town of Minden October 21, 1874, and spent practically all her life in Fort Plain. She was a member of the Fort Plain Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, and Otsquago Chapter, Order of Eastern Star. She was a charter member of Fort Plain Unit, American Legion Auxiliary.

She was a member of the Fort Plain Universalist Church and the Chapin Club of the church.

The survivors are one sister, Mrs. Lauren Kellogg, Amsterdam, and one niece, Mrs. Fred Shockley, Fort Plain.
