Roy W. Hopson Expires at 71

Roy William (Jake) Hopson, 71, of Dolgeville, died Saturday in the Veterans Administration hospital at Syracuse after a long illness. He was born March 24, 1892 in Dolgeville, the son of William and Sarah Lyons Hopson.

He had been employed in the local Postoffice from 1923 until his retirement in 1949 and was one of the first three letter carriers in this village.

Mr. Hopson was a member of the First Universalist Church, Dolgeville; and a member of the American Legion Post of Dolgeville, being a veteran of World War I. Surviving are several cousins.
