MRS. ELIZABETH HOUGHTALING
Former Resident of McLean Dies at Home in Cortland

Mrs. Elizabeth Houghtaling, 75, the wife of A. L. Houghtaling of 102 1-2 Clinton-ave. passed away at her home Sunday morning about 4 o'clock. Although Mrs. Houghtaling has suffered from the effects of rheumatism for many years, she bore her period of ill health with great fortitude. Mrs. Houghtaling was born at Meredith, Delaware county, on Sept. 22, 1851. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James [Maryette Hoyt] McMurray. She spent the greater part of her life at McLean, coming to this city to make her home about five years ago. She was a member of the Universalist church of this city. Besides her husband, she leaves two sons, H. J. Houghtaling of Schenectady and C. L. Houghtaling of this city; and her two brothers, Robert McMurray of Vestal and John McMurray of Fulton. The private funeral service will be held at the late residence tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock. The Rev. J. [Joseph] A. Judge, pastor of the Universalist church, will officiate. Friends, who may call at their convenience, are kindly asked to omit flowers. The burial will be made in the McLean cemetery.
