## Sudden Death in Newville

Chauncey Houpt, one of the best known citizens of the town of Danube, died at his home in Newville shortly after the noon hour yesterday. Mr. Houpt was working on his farm, about a half mile from his residence, superintending the cutting of logs, when he was stricken with apoplexy. He was taken to his home and Dr. Tibbitts summoned. The stricken man died one hour later. Mr. Houpt was born in Newville in 1846 and always resided there, where he has one of the finest residences in that section. He was a Republican in politics and a leader in the affairs of his town. His widow [Amelia Walrath Houpt, who later married Ivan Zoller] and three sons, Henry, Chauncey and Samuel Houpt, survive. The funeral will be held Saturday at 12 o'clock. The Rev. H. E. Benton of the Universalist Church of this city will officiate.
