McLean—Alvin F. Howard, aged 63 died Tuesday morning at his home in McLean. He was the son of William and Betsy Nash Howard and had lived in McLean all of his life.

He had been a member of the board of assessors of the town for twenty-seven years and was its chairman at the time of his death. He had been a director of the Groton and Dryden Cooperative Insurance company for nine years, and was its president when he died. For twelve years he had been secretary of the McLean Cemetery association and for many years he was a trustee of the First Universalist church of McLean. He was a retired farmer. He is survived by his widow, who before her marriage was Mrs. Flora L. Manzer of Solvay; two brothers, Allen and Burdette of Cortland; two daughters, Mrs. Louise Palmer and Miss Edna Howard of Arlington, Wash.

The funeral was held yesterday afternoon, burial in McLean cemetery.
