On election day after voting[,] Edwin A. Howard went to visit his daughter, Mrs. John Jordan, at North Bay, and on the morning of the 12th, upon going to awaken him, [she] found that he had passed peacefully away during the night. The sad news was wired to his family here and his son Emery, with Undertaker Richmond, went after the remains that day. Mr. Howard was 74 years old last September and was born and lived on the home farm on the hill northeast of Pine Woods until he moved to Bouckville about twelve years ago. There survive besides his widow one son, Emery, with whom they made their home; two daughters, Mrs. John Jordan of North Bay, and Mrs. Leslie Peck of this place; five grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Mr. Howard was a kind neighbor and friend and a good citizen, and will be greatly missed from our village. The funeral was held from his late home on Saturday, Rev. W. C. Selleck [Universalist] of Utica officiating. Interment made in Madison.
