The funeral of Mrs. Elizabeth Dolloff Howard was held at the home of her daughter, Miss Ellen F. Howard, Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock, Rev. Dewitt Lamphear officiating. Mrs. Howard was born in Rome [on] October 14, 1836, and she married Robert S. Howard [on] January 1, 1856. They went to Iowa and after five years returned and lived on a farm near Mohawk. Seven years later they moved to Cedarville. Thirty-eight years ago they removed here, where 14 years ago he died. Their son, Henry Hudson Howard, a prominent farmer, died suddenly a year ago in December. A son, Stephen D. Howard, resides in this village. Mrs. Howard was a home loving woman, devoted to her family. From childhood she attended the Universalist Church. She is [also] survived by one granddaughter, Mrs. Wm. D. Brown, and a great grandson, Howard D. Brown.
