

[Howard, Idalia Bridge]

BOUCKVILLE

Bouckville, April 14.—Mrs. Idalia Howard, aged 85, died April 6, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Leslie Peck. Mrs. Howard fractured her hip by a fall and had been confined to her bed for fifteen months. Idalia Bridge was born in Stockbridge August 10, 1845, a daughter of the late Jonas and Mary Underwood Bridge. She was educated in [the] Bouckville school and Hamilton Seminary. She married Edwin A. Howard at Earlville on February 3, 1870. Mr. Howard died in 1919. Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. John Jordan of Syracuse, and Mrs. Peck, and one son, Emery S. Howard of Bouckville; two sisters, Mrs. Ella Brennan of Rochester and Mrs. Mae Baker of Buffalo; also five grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Funeral services were held from the Peck home Thursday afternoon, Rev. Alfred Cole of Madison Universalist Church officiating. Burial was at Madison.
