The death of Mrs. Mary McLouth Howard, widow of the late Theodore Howard, of Lansing, Mich., occurred last week Monday afternoon at the home of her sister, Mrs. Jessie Adams of this town. Mrs. Howard was a daughter of the late Marshall and Margaret Pratt McLouth, and was born in this town on May 28, 1848 and was 76 years old. Nearly all of her life she resided in this town with the exception of a few years spent in Michigan. She is survived by one sister, Mrs. Adams, and several nieces and nephews. Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at 2:30 from the home of her sister, conducted by Rev. George Porter, pastor of the Universalist church at Macedon. Interment was made in Brookside cemetery at Shortsville. Mrs. Howard had been a consistent member of the Universalist church at Macedon for many years and was highly esteemed by all who knew her.
