Mrs. Theodosia A. Howell.

The death of Mrs. Theodosia A. Howell occurred at her home, 421 N. Washington street at 4:20 o'clock on Tuesday afternoon. She had been in poor health since last Christmas and had an attack of grip about five weeks ago from which she nearly had recovered, but she suffered a relapse and meningitis developed, which was the cause of her death. She had been unconscious since Saturday morning. Her maiden name was Letts, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Palmer Letts of Taberg, at which place she was born. On May 21, 1879, she was married in Rome to Henry C. Harris who died at Kensington, Ill., on May 27, 1891. [On] August 13, 1893, in Chicago, she married Dr. Lyle A. Howell. Besides her husband she is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Benjamin Sawyer of this city, and two brothers, Byron D. Letts of Taberg and Lester K. Letts of Utica. Mrs. Howell was of pleasing personality and her many friends will deeply regret her passing. She was a member of the Universalist Church and also of the Queen Esther Rebekah Lodge, I.O.O.F., Martha Washington Council, Daughters of Liberty and the Lady Maccabees.
