LeRoy Howland

Funeral services were held Saturday in Schenectady for LeRoy Howland, 39, of 1921 Bernice street, that city, who died last Wednesday in Ellis Hospital.

Military honors were accorded during the service, while later in the afternoon, committal services were conducted by the Rev. James Alcock, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain, at the Fort Plain Cemetery.

LeRoy Howland, the son of Don and Minnetta Dunckle Howland, Nelliston, was a graduate of Fort Plain High School and attended Nott Terrace Advance High School, Schenectady, for one year.

He was a member of the Theta Phi fraternity, Fort Plain, and served for four years in the U.S. Navy during World War II, receiving his discharge with a rating of Petty Officer First Class.

A member of Schenectady American Legion Post No. 1001, he was also affiliated with the Schenectady County Legion organization. He was also a member of the Schenectady Navy Reserve unit.

He was associated with the New York Central Railroad where he had been employed since his graduation from high school.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his wife, the former Kathryn Parsons, of Cherry Valley.

A young man of high character, he had many friends in both the Fort Plain-Nelliston community and Schenectady.
