WILLIAM J. HOYT

Canajoharie—William J. Hoyt, 82, of Canajoharie RD 1, died Feb. 12, 1959, at his home after a long illness.

A retired farmer, he was born Jan. 1, 1877, son of Charles and Annie McDonald Hoyt.

Mr. Hoyt was a member of Canajoharie Lodge, IOOF, and Maple Town Grange.

His wife, the former Mary Flint [Baum<sup>1</sup>], died in 1951.

He leaves four daughters, Mrs. Carl Kretzer, Utica; Mrs. Harry Herringshaw, Mrs. Voorhees Kougher, and Miss Florence Hoyt, all of Canajoharie RD 1.

The funeral was at 2 Sunday from the home, with the Rev. Raymond Scott, pastor of Fort Plain Universalist Church, officiating. The body was placed in the vault of the Canajoharie Falls Cemetery for burial in the spring in Maple Town Cemetery.
