Death of Mrs. Rossman Husted

Hattie E. Miller, widow of Rossman Husted, died at her home, 532 Union street, Sunday afternoon, about 5 o'clock. She had been ailing for some time, and had been a patient in the City Hospital several months ago. In passing away she soon followed her husband, who died on December 26th last. They had no children and were greatly attached to one another, and when Mr. Husted took upon him the sleep of death it was a blow that deeply grieved her and probably hastened her demise.

Mrs. Husted was born in this city and always resided here. She was a daughter of Henry and Sarah J. Miller, both of whom have passed away, and the only survivors of her family are a sister, Mrs. Henry W. Alden, and a brother, Henry L. Miller, of this city. She was a member of the Universalist church, and had the respect and esteem of a large circle of friends. The funeral will be private from her late residence on Union street Wednesday afternoon.
