After a year of post-graduate work [e.g. employment] she went to Syracuse University for a year in music. Sixteen years ago she married Thomas Huey. They lived a few years in Middletown, then removed to Jordan, where her parents had also gone, and Mr. Huey became a member of the firm of A. J. Rising & Sons. She attended the Universalist Church and was interested in music circles, but [was] especially devoted to and happy in her home. She leaves, besides her husband and parents, two children, a son, Arthur Leslie, and a daughter, Claire Luella; a sister, Miss Florence Rising, and brother, Arthur; three uncles, H. Orville, Charles, and Earl M. Rising, reside here with their families. Our terrible storm made it impossible for them to get to Jordan for the funeral, which was held Monday afternoon.
