MARCUS W. HULL Well Known Resident of the Tenth Ward Died This Morning

Marcus W. Hull, an old and well known resident, died at his home, 102 Park avenue, at 4 o'clock this morning. He had been ailing for a number of years and had been confined to his bed for the past three years as the result of paralysis.

Mr. Hull was born in Utica and always resided here. The date of his birth was August 15, 1832. He was educated in private and public schools of the city. When a young man he became engaged in the grocery business with his father, at the corner of Mary street and Park avenue. When his father retired he continued the business until failing health would not permit. He made his home in the rear of the store at present located there. At one time the buildings located there were used as a private school. Mr. Hull was a member of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. In politics he was a Democrat.

Besides his wife [Ellen] he is survived by one sister, Miss Helen Hull, and one brother, Albert Hull of St. Louis.
