FUNERAL OF MRS. HUMPHREY

The interment of Mrs. Anna E. Campbell, widow of Oscar Humphrey, was held in city cemetery here this afternoon following the arrival of the 2:40 train from Albany, where funeral services had been held at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George Underhill, No. 23 Western avenue. Mrs. Humphrey had been almost a life-long resident of Hudson, about a year ago going to Albany to reside with her daughter there. Her husband died many years ago. Besides the Albany daughter she is survived by the following children: Mrs. Geo. Welsh, whose husband is a physician in Hartford, Conn.; Edwin, who is in the New York Custom House; and Harry of Riverville, and Miss Nellie Humphrey, of this city. The committal service was in charge of the Rev. G.[George] D. Walker, of the Universalist church.
