Victor friends have received word of the death of Mrs. Sarah Miller Humphrey, which occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. E. H. Wilmarth [Stella Willmarth], in Racine, Wisconsin, on Thursday of this week. The deceased was the widow of Hiram H. Humphrey who died in 1894. She was sixty-eight years old. For the greater part of her life she resided in Victor, leaving here three years ago to go to the home of her only daughter in Racine. She was for many years a member of St. Paul's Universalist church, and many estimable qualities of heart and mind had gained for her a wide circle of friends who will learn of her death with sincere regret. The remains will be brought here for interment, arriving, it is expected, on Saturday. Funeral services will be held at the home of Mrs. L. [Luman] P. Miller, south of this village, Saturday afternoon at four o'clock, Rev. Margaret Brennan officiating. Interment will be made in Boughton Hill Cemetery.
