Death came suddenly late Monday afternoon to Mrs. Fannie M. Hunt, wife of Rensselaer K. Hunt, at the family home near Watertown Center. Mrs. Hunt had suffered from an affection of the heart for some time, but her condition, on arising Monday morning, was no worse than it had been for some time. She became ill soon, however, and grew rapidly worse until her death later in the afternoon.

Mrs. Hunt was born in the town of Adams 70 years ago, the daughter of John and Fannie Cooley. Forty-five years ago she was married and took up her residence near Watertown Center, where she lived continuously until her death. She was a woman of kindly disposition and lovable character.

Besides her husband she is survived by three sisters, Mrs. H. M. Fuller of Fulton, Mrs. S. S. Fuller of Watertown Center and Mrs. S. H. Case of Santa Monica, California, and by two brothers, A. K. Cooley of Adams Center and J. R. Cooley of Ottawa, Ill.

The funeral will be held from her late home Thursday afternoon at 2 p.m. Rev. Moses H. Harris, D.D., pastor of All Souls church [Universalist], will conduct the service. Interment will be made in Brookside cemetery.
