Delora M. Hunter died on Saturday afternoon, at Thanksgiving Hospital, at the age of sixty-eight years, nine months and two days. He had been suffering with kidney trouble for some time and had been a patient in the hospital for several weeks. The funeral was held at his late home on Susquehanna avenue, at 2 o'clock, Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. George Wilson Scudder [Universalist] officiating. Interment in Lakewood cemetery.

Mr. Hunter's boyhood was passed on the farm of his father in Beaver Meadow. Later for several years he successfully conducted a store in Middlefield Centre and from that village moved to Cooperstown where for a time he was the proprietor of a grocery store.

He married Miss Harriet Newell who survives him and who through many years of invalidism was devotedly cared for by her husband. Mr. Hunter served as village collector for a number of terms.

Surviving Mr. Hunter besides his wife are one son, Fred, of this village, one brother, Silas Hunter, and one sister, Mrs. George Tarpinning, both of the town of Middlefield. Homer Hunter of Cooperstown is a nephew of the deceased and there are a number of other relatives living in this vicinity.
