"Grandma Hunting" as she was affectionately called, passed to the higher life Feb. 21, 1927, at the remarkable age of 95.

Her mind was clear and keen, and she was deeply interested in the activities of her beloved church, with which she had been connected since childhood.

She was the oldest member of All Souls Church at Watertown, N.Y., and from her rich treasure-house of mind and heart, she could relate much of the early history of Universalism in the north country, even remembering Pitt Morse, the founder of the Universalist Church in Watertown and its first Pastor.
