William Hutchinson Dies, Retired Teacher

William M. Hutchinson, 58, former Monroe High School teacher, died yesterday (Jan. 7, 1957) of a nerve condition. He had been ill for some time.

Mr. Hutchinson taught general science and biology from 1923 to 1945 at Monroe High. He retired in 1945.

His wife, Celia Hutchinson, is a mathematics teacher at the same school. The couple lived at 49 Rowley St.

Born in Rochester, Mr. Hutchinson was the son of Dr. and Mrs. Orville Hutchinson. He was a graduate of St. Lawrence University and the University of Rochester. Some of his interests included membership in the First Universalist Church, the Rochester Numismatic Association, the Monroe Garden Club and a number of educational groups.

Besides his wife, he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Gerald Cushing and Mrs. Robert Drexler; a son, William Hutchinson; and two brothers, Edwin of Rochester and Ralph of Syracuse.

Friends may call from 3 to 5 and 7 to 8 p.m. today at the Hedges Memorial Chapel, 271 University Ave. A memorial service will be held at 4 p.m. tomorrow at the First Universalist Church. Burial will be in Canton, N.Y.
