Perryville—Funeral services for Mrs. Carrie Hyatt of Rochester, were held at the home of her brother and wife, Mr. and Mrs. John Hill, Wednesday afternoon, Dec. 8, with Rev. Albert Stearns of Canastota, officiating. Burial was in the local cemetery. Mrs. Hyatt was born here in Perryville Aug. 22, 1861. She married Elmer Shaut in 1886 and went to Little Falls to live. He died in a short time and she returned to Perryville. In January, 1900, she married Theodore Hyatt here in Perryville and until his death, in 1931, she lived here. Then she went to make her home in Rochester with her daughter and husband, Dr. and Mrs. Jacob Deuel. She spent all of her summers here at the home of her brother. She was a member of the Universalist Church. She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Deuel, three grandchildren and two great grandchildren and her brother, John Hill. She leaves many friends here, who will miss her.
