## Obituary.

Yesterday morning occurred the death of Mrs. Nettie<sup>1</sup> Hyde, wife of Hamilton Hyde, of 51 West street, aged 62 years. Mrs. Hyde had been ill over a year, the affliction being a lupus cancer. Last November the deceased reached an alarming stage, and the life of the sufferer was despaired of. She became better, however, but did not improve as rapidly as watching friends hoped. Since that time through her intense sufferings, she never complained, and with a patience and loving disposition that was rare, she exemplified the Christianity in which she believed. Her kindly nature was a matter of remark among those who were with her during her last months, and her faith in the religion which she professed gave proof of a beautiful character. She was a member of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. Mrs. Hyde was married in this city 30 years ago, and besides a husband, there survive two children, Frank C., of Albany, and Miss Marion E., of this city. Three sisters<sup>2</sup> also survive, living in Lockport. The funeral, which will be private, will be held from the house this afternoon. Interment will be at Lockport<sup>3</sup>.
