OBITUARY

PERRY F. IRISH, 57 years old, formerly a resident of 276 Ninth street and widely known in Republican affairs in the Twelfth Assembly District, died yesterday of heart failure at the residence of his brother-in-law, Robert Buhsen, 612 East Twenty-first street, Flatbush. His funeral services will be held there tomorrow afternoon, conducted by the Rev. Dr. A. Eugene Bartlett, pastor of All Souls Universalist Church, Ocean and Ditmas avenues, which Mr. Irish joined soon after he went to Flatbush to live. Mr. Irish was born in Brooklyn, the son of the late Dr. Lucius B. and Jennie M. Irish. His father was a pharmacist of lower Fulton street and later a medical practitioner. Mrs. Buhsen, the sister of Mr. Irish, died about a year ago and he leaves no near relatives. He was an expert telegraph operator and for thirty-five years had been employed in the main office of the Western Union Telegraph Company.
