Hugo Jacchia, Minstrel Singer, Taken By Death

DOLGEVILLE—Hugo Jacchia, well known local resident, died at 1:30 Tuesday morning at the Fremen's home in Hudson, where he had been a patient for the past three months. Death was due to complications. Mr. Jacchia was born June 16, 1[???] in London, England. He was a well known singer, having traveled for the Richard Carl, Hi-Henry and Primrose and West minstrel shows under the stage name of Hugo Angelo. Retiring from the stage about [18?] years ago, he came to Dolgeville and had resided here since that time, where he was employed by the Daniel Green Co. as a stockman until the time of his illness. He was a member of the Alfred Dolge Hose Co. here and the Elks club of Little Falls.

The survivors are one son, Paul Jacchia, who is somewhere in the Pacific and one brother, Albert Jacchia of Dolgeville.

The funeral will be held at 2 Friday from the Jacobson funeral home. The Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church will officiate. Burial will be in the Dolgeville cemetery. Firemen will attend the service in a body and act as bearers.
