Frank Jackson Dies; Mohawk Resident

MOHAWK—Frank Jackson, 79, a caretaker of the Mohawk Cemetery for 10 years, died yesterday at his home, 4 Bellinger St., after a short illness.

He was born Jan. 23, 1876 in Mohawk, a son of William Foster and Ann Mantle Jackson. Besides being caretaker, he was a member of the Mohawk Cemetery Commission.

On Oct. 3, 1922, he married Maud Witherstine in the Herkimer Universalist Church, with the Rev. James Riley, pastor, officiating.

Surviving, besides his wife, are four nieces, Mrs. Florence Moore and Mrs. Etta Becker, both of California, Mrs. Louis Prevost, Herkimer, Mrs. Norton Helmer; two nephews, Fred Fetterly, Arizona; Floyd E. Jackson, East Herkimer.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Monday from the Graves Funeral Home, 48 East Main St., with the Rev. Stanley C. Stall, Herkimer First Universalist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery, Herkimer.
