Early Friday morning occurred the death of Mr. Abram Jacobson, one of our aged residents, who has been in failing health or a long time. Jacobson, who was in his eighty-fifth year, was born in Columbia and was one of a family of eight children, of whom only one survives him, his brother, Henry Jacobson, who resides in Ilion. In 1836 he was married to Miss Fannie Orendorf. They kept a hotel in Columbia and will be pleasantly remembered by their many patrons of those days. In 1861 they moved here and for about 25 years kept the village hotel, when he gave it up to his son, since which time he has lived guietly in his home here and of late years both Mr. and Mrs. Jacobson have spent part of every year with their daughter, Mrs. Orpha Woolaber [Wollaber], in Elizabethtown, on the old Orendorf homestead. Rev. S. [Samuel] R. Ward [Universalist] conducted the funeral services at two o'clock Sunday, and the house was filled with relatives and sympathizing friends. Mr. Jacobson is survived by his wife, daughter, Mrs. Orpha Woolaber [Woollaber], and son, Orville Jacobson. Mr. Henry Jacobson and other relatives came from Ilion, Columbia and Jordanville.
