Chester Bradford Jarvis died in the County Hospital, Thursday morning, in his sixty-ninth year. He was a son of the late Frederick T. Jarvis of Hartwick Seminary and here he passed the most of his life. He was quiet and unassuming with always a kind word to friends and neighbors. He is survived by two brothers, Ira S. Jarvis and J. W. Jarvis and four nephews. He was a lineal descendant of Gov. Bradford, the first governor of Massachusetts being of the seventh generation.

Burial will be made in the family plot at Fly Creek, Saturday afternoon at 3 o'clock. The Rev. George C. Boorn of the Universalist church will have charge of the service.
