EDWIN M. JARVIS

Edwin M. Jarvis, aged 93, of Fly Creek RD 1, died Sunday evening, November 19 in the Mary Imogene Bassett Hospital in Cooperstown, after a long period of declining health.

Mr. Jarvis was born July 27, 1874, on Christian Hill, Town of Hartwick, the son of Frank and Lucy (Gibbs) Jarvis. He married Lena Lindsay in 1895. She died in October 1924. On November 26, 1926, he married Mabel Foster at Cooperstown. Mr. Jarvis was a graduate of Cooperstown High School and St. Lawrence Theological School in 1896. He was a Universalist minister for about three years after graduation. He was a mail carrier out of Fly Creek Post Office for many years and operated a farm from which he retired about 23 years ago.

He was a former superintendent of the Fly Creek Cemetery Association and was assessor for the Town of Otsego for many years. He was a 75-year member of the Fly Creek Grange and a seventh degree member. He had held the office of master as well as several other Grange offices. He was also a member of Pomona, State and National Grange and was a past master of Pomona Grange. He had attended the Universalist Church[es] of Fly Creek, Cooperstown and Schuyler Lake.

Surviving are his wife; a daughter, Mrs. Phyllis Talbot of Fly Creek and a niece.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, November 22, from the Ingalls Funeral Home in Cooperstown, with the Rev. Albert F. Almstedt, pastor of the Fly Creek Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Fly Creek Cemetery.
