Mrs. Frederick T. Jarvis

The death of Mrs. Frederick T. Jarvis occurred at her home in the town of Hartwick, Sunday, April 21st. She was born in the same town, October 7, 1826. Her father was a native of Rhode Island and her grandfather was one of the early settlers of the town of Hartwick, coming to this section in 1792 with a view of settlement, and making the journey on foot from Rhode Island. He selected a plot of land in what is now Hartwick, built a log hut in the depths of the forest, and then returned to Rhode Island for his family. Mrs. Jarvis has been a member of the Church of the Messiah, Universalist, for many years and in her younger days was always present at its services. Surviving her are two sons, Ira S. and Wilson Jarvis. The funeral service was held from her late home on Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. William G. Cortright officiating. Interment was made at Hartwick Seminary.
