Death Takes Wife Of Former Warden At Auburn Prison

Auburn—Services for Mrs. Louise Robinson Jennings, wife of Gen. Edgar S. Jennings of "Dogwood," E. Lake Rd., who died yesterday in Auburn City Hospital, will be at 2 p. m. tomorrow in the Lester E. Brew Funeral Chapel. The Rev. Hal T. Kearns [Universalist] will officiate. Burial will be in Fort Hill Cemetery. Mrs. Jennings, a lifelong resident of Auburn, and her husband, a former warden of Auburn Prison, spent the Winter months at Bradenton, Fla. Mr. Jennings was warden of the prison during the riots in July and December, 1929. He retired in 1930. Surviving, besides her husband are two sisters, Julia and Agnes Robinson, both of Auburn, a brother, Frederick W. Robinson, Auburn, and a nephew, Charles D. Robinson, Newburgh.
