FT. PLAIN RITES SET WEDNESDAY FOR MRS. JEWELL

FORT PLAIN—Lulu Hagadorn Jewell, 54, wife of Jesse Jewell, Northville R.D. 1, died Saturday morning at 7:15 in Ellis Hospital, Schenectady, where she had been a patient for two days. She had been ill several months.

Mrs. Jewell was born March 29, 1910, at Nelliston, a daughter of Frank and Rebecca Rackmyer Hagadorn, and attended the Fort Plain Universalist Church. A graduate of Fort Plain High School and Amsterdam City Hospital School of Nursing and was employed for 20 years as plant nurse by the Bigelow-Sanford Carpet Co. in Amsterdam. She had lived in Northville since her retirement in 1954.

Surviving are her husband, Jesse Jewell, to whom she was married Aug. 27, 1938; one aunt, Miss Lulu Rackmyer, Fort Lauderdale, Fla., and several cousins.

The body was removed to the Gray funeral home, Fort Plain, where the funeral will be held Wednesday at 3:30 p.m., the Rev. Raymond Scott of the Fort Plain Universalist Church officiating. Burial will be in Fort Plain Cemetery.
