MRS. ANNA A. JOHNSON

Anna A. Allen, widow of the late George Henry Johnson died at her home in this village, Tuesday evening, October 24th.

She was ninety-one years old and was born in Canada, January 2, 1842. Her parents were Abraham and Emma Hodgkins Allen. When a child of two years, she moved to Cherry Valley, and later to Springfield Center, removing to this village in 1869. Her marriage to Mr. Johnson took place in 1870. She was a member of the Universalist church.

Mrs. Johnson is survived by one son, Earl Johnson, of Princeton, N.J., three daughters, Mrs. John Yeoman of this village, Mrs. Emma M. Lewis of Princeton, and Mrs. Lulu McGrath of Whitesboro, by an adopted son, Fred A. Johnson, one grandson and three great-grandchildren, and by a sister, Mrs. Amy Wilbur, of this village.

The funeral will be held Friday morning at her home and the interment will be in Lake View cemetery.
