Mrs. Ellen May Clarke Johnson, aged 96, widow of Marquis D. Johnson, died Wednesday at 3 a.m. at the home of her son, Arel Johnson of Schuyler Lake from injuries suffered when she fell and broke her hip Sunday night.

Mrs. Johnson, who was born October 31, 1861, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. LeRoy Clarke, was married twice. Her first husband was Frank Stevens, by whom she had three children, Irving Stevens of Edmeston, Arthur Stevens of Walton, and Mrs. Seymour Hatch of Fredonia, who died five years ago.

Her second husband, Marquis Johnson, died in August, 1923. They had one son, Arel, who survives. Also surviving are a brother, Clayton Clarke, of Herkimer, and five grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Friday at 2 p.m. at the Universalist church, Schuyler Lake, with burial in Schuyler Lake cemetery.
