Enos, youngest child of John and Lois (Brainerd) Johnson, was born March 21, 1786, in East Hampton. He was a farmer residing in Burlington [Otsego Co.] New York, later in North Pitcher and South Otselic. He was a Universalist in religion. He married, September 23, 1810, Anna Parmelee, born June 25, 1785, died at South Otselic, New York, September 24, 1858, daughter of John Parmelee... [Bryan Parmelee and Rebecca Cone] were the parents of John Parmelee, whose daughter Anna became the wife of Enos Johnson. Children of Mr. and Mrs. Johnson: Lucy Ann, John Jewett, Lois Louisa, Enos.
